

## Money from the Government for Sports Support

### Employment of an Experienced Sports Coach

We employ a sports coach to deliver some PE and Sports teaching. He works alongside a member of staff to improve her skills. He works to the timetable and long term plans which have been put together by the teacher responsible for PE and Sport to ensure the children have a balanced programme across the year. The coach offers support for the teachers to develop their own skills in planning and teaching this subject.

### Employment of an LSA to support the delivery of PE and Sport

We are using some of the money to pay for an LSA to support the delivery of PE and Sport. Her role is to work closely with the PE coach to help develop her own skills and to ensure that the children are well supported and individuals can receive extra support in lessons. She is building towards delivery of clubs at lunchtime in several sports. She accompanies the children to matches when possible and supports the teachers as needed in PE and Sport.

### **Equipment to support the delivery of PE and Sport**

Money is being spent on equipment that is needed to deliver high quality PE and Sport. The range of sports offered to the children is wider and equipment is purchased to ensure that we have been able to do this successfully. The children have participated successfully in events in the local inter school sports competitions. We aim to take part in the majority of the local sports events to ensure that our children have the opportunity to stay fit and experience the enjoyment of physical activity. All abilities are catered for from county level participation to sportability events for children who find the activities more demanding. We also participate in the Change for Life programme which is very successful and one of the members of staff has been trained to run this club. He works closely with the PE coordinator to target children who are less active. Money is used to support the purchase of equipment and ingredients to ensure that the children are well supported to become more active and aware of healthy eating.

### **Swimming**

Support is given to ensure that all children from Year 2 to Year 6 have the opportunity to attend swimming. The money supports payment for all children to attend as it is subsidised. It also supports payment for the three swimming coaches who ensure that the coaching is of a high quality.

### **Transport costs**

Use of the minibus for children to attend sports fixtures out of school is supported by money from PE Sports Funding. The donations made by the parents in supporting this resource are small so funding is used to subsidise costs.
